EQUITY MARKET

Innovation-Led Sectors Driving Growth





Q1 earnings highlighted strong momentum in capital markets, technology, renewables, EVs, and healthcare, which continue to outpace broader indices and reinforce their role as key alpha drivers. While US tariffs on textiles, leather, and metals create noise, the impact on Indian equities is limited, as major sectors like pharma and electronics remain unaffected.

Valuations have corrected meaningfully: Nifty has stayed flat over the past year while earnings expanded ~8%, supported by lower rates and better liquidity.

This provides a strong base for outperformance as sentiment revives, with focused, growth-aligned portfolios positioned better than overly diversified ones.

September begins on a constructive note with robust earnings, resilient macro trends, and attractive valuations. Investors who maintain exposure to high-growth, innovation-led sectors are likely to benefit, while India's long-term growth trajectory and global positioning remain intact despite near-term trade volatility.



DEBT MARKET

Limited Duration Play, Strong Case for Quality Bonds

Global bond markets have turned more stable after the resolution of US tariff disputes and the passage of the expenditure bill. The US 10-year yield has held in the 4.20–4.40% range, and with labor market data softening, the US Federal Reserve is widely expected to cut rates in its September meeting. This move should provide support to global debt markets and reduce volatility

In India, the RBI has stayed on hold after its April rate cut, maintaining a neutral stance despite inflation dropping to 1.6% in July—the lowest in several years.

Concerns around fiscal slippage due to the GST rate cut announcement had pushed the 10-year yield higher to 6.65%, but with the revenue impact contained at ₹48,000 crore, yields have eased to about 6.52%. The bar for further RBI rate cuts remains high in the near term, though slowing growth could trigger policy support later in the year.

Given this backdrop, duration opportunities are limited, and investors are better placed focusing on short- to medium-duration debt funds with higher allocations to quality corporate bonds. Categories such as Corporate Bond Funds, Banking & PSU Debt Funds, and Short Duration Funds offer attractive carry at current yield levels. Aligning debt allocation with investment horizon and risk appetite will remain the key to navigating markets this month.

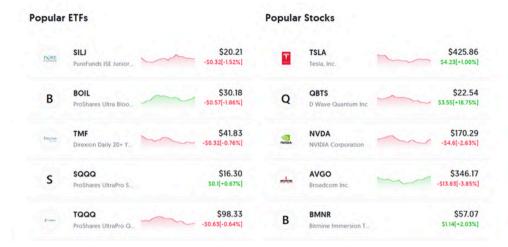

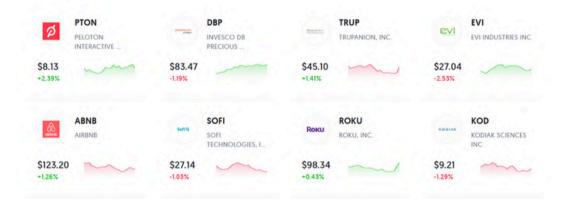

INDIA'S GROWTH STORY: PMI PEAKS, GST 2.0 POWERS MOMENTUM

The services sector (PMI) touched a 15-year high, powered by new orders and strong demand. At the same time, the rollout of GST 2.0 was hailed as a multi-target reform that streamlines taxes, moderates inflation and boosts fiscal transparency. Together, these factors reinforce India's position as a resilient, thriving economy.

The momentum was further boosted by tax cuts ahead of the festive season, with GST rates on essentials and consumer durables slashed to stimulate demand. Analysts expect these measures to add up to 120 basis points to GDP over the next four to six quarters.

While global headwinds such as U.S. tariffs and commodity price swings pose challenges, India's strong domestic demand, buoyant tax collections, and proactive reforms continue to provide a solid cushion. The impressive 7.8% GDP growth highlights India's resilience, and with policy momentum supporting long-term stability, the macroeconomic outlook remains firmly optimistic.

Global markets are entering what analysts call a "postmodern era," marked by slower globalization, shifting demographics, and ongoing geopolitical fragmentation. While traditional growth models face pressure, trade flows remain more resilient than headlines suggest. Supply chains are being rerouted rather than dismantled, with countries like Vietnam, Mexico, and Poland emerging as alternative hubs.

At the same time, manufacturing growth remains fragile, with Europe lagging but the U.S. and China providing steady support. For investors, this changing landscape underscores the importance of active strategies, geographic diversification, and adaptation to new structural realities shaping global markets.
